Cambodia

Visa Information

Unless you are from Laos, Malaysia, Philippines or Singapore you need a visa.

You may obtain your visa upon arrival at the two airports in Cambodia: Siem Reap and Phnom Penh. You will need \$20 US cash for a tourist visa and \$25 for business. Along with it you will need one passport size photo and your passport must be valid for six month. Everyone who does not hold a Cambodian passport needs a visa to enter the country. (Except Malaysian and Philipinos.)

A visa can be issued upon arrival at the border checkpoints into Cambodia. Border checkpoints Cambodia-Thailand: O'smach (Oddar Meanchay Province), Poipet (Beantey MeanChay Province), and Cham Yeam (Koh Kong Province). Border checkpoints Cambodia-Vietnam: Bavet (Svay Rieng Province) and Kaom Samnor(Kandal Province). We have had recent reports that a visa on arrival can be had at the border with Laos, (just north of Stung Treng) to Laos (near Si Phan Don).

Your can apply for visa at Royal Embassy of Cambodia in Singapore or you can obtain your visa upon arrival at all checkpoints.

You must be ready with the following items: passport with validity not less than 6 months, 2 recent passport size photos, 2 completed full fill application forms. The visa fee is US\$ 20. It take 3 business days to process for embassy' visa.

Nationals from Afghanistan, Algeria, Arab Saudi, Bangladesh, Iran, Iraq, Pakistan, Sri Lanka and Sudan are not eligible for an e-visa.
